RELEVANT FACT

The Board of Directors of “MEDIASET ESPAÑA COMUNICACION, S.A.”, at a meeting held on 27th February, 2013, have unanimously adopted, amongst others, the below resolutions summarized from the Minutes of the meeting:

One.- To draft the annual accounts, Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss Account, Statement of Changes in Equity, Cash Flow Statement and Notes to the Annual Financial Statements, and the Board of Directors’ Management Report of MEDIASET ESPAÑA COMUNICACION, S.A. and Consolidated Statement of Financial Position, Income Separate Consolidated Global Profit and Loss Statement Consolidated Statement of Changes in Equity and Consolidated Cash Flow Statement Consolidated, including the Consolidated Management Report of its Consolidated Group of Companies for the year to 31st December 2012, as well as the proposed distribution of profit for the period, which is as follows:

Two.- To convene the Shareholders’ Annual General Meeting, to be held in Madrid at Mediaset España, Carretera de Fuencarral a Alcobendas, 4 at 12:00 on April 17th 2013 on first call or, if necessary, on April 18th 2013 on second call, at the same place and time.

Three.- To jointly delegate powers to the Chairman of the Board and the two Chief Executive Officers so that they may suppress or modify any of the items of the Annual General Meeting’s Agenda, as well as add new ones.

Four.- To approve the Annual Corporate Governance Report for the financial year 2012.

It is hereby noted that the Annual Corporate Governance Report will be soon filed with Spain’s Securities Market Regulator and made available to shareholders and investors through the company’s website (www.mediaset.es).

It is also noted that the full text of the proposed resolutions to be submitted for approval by the Annual General Meeting, as well as the rest of the information and documents to be submitted for approval by the Annual General Meeting, will be made available to shareholders immediately upon making the General Meeting known through the requisite notices to be published in the Official Mercantile Registry Gazette (BORME), in the newspapers and on the company’s website (www.mediaset.es).
