## **TELECINCO CINEMA, IS THE PRODUCER WITH THE MOST NOMINATIONS IN THE GOYA AWARDS WITH 21 CANDIDATES**

- **THE IMPOSSIBLE** has been nominated in 14 categories among which Best Picture, Best Director, Best Original Screenplay, Best Actress (Naomi Watts), Best Supporting Actor (Ewan McGregor) and Best Male Newcomer (Tom Holland)
- **THE ADVENTURES OF TADEO JONES** has been selected for five awards: to the Best Animation Film, Best New Director, Best Adapted Screenplay, Best Original Score and Best Original Song
- **TWICE BORN**, which opens in theaters on Friday, and the short film **NEFERTITIS HAND** have been nominated in the categories of Best Actress (Penelope Cruz) and Best Animated Short Film, respectively
- With **THE IMPOSSIBLE** and **THE ADVENTURES OF TADEO JONES** Telecinco Cinema has boosted the industry in our country, generating sales of nearly six out of ten cinema tickets in 2012 and has taken 60 million Euros, 56% of the global box office
- These two films were also nominated for the Gaudi Awards from the Catalan Film Academy with 6 and 4 nominations, respectively
- Telecinco Cinema accumulates 47 Goya Awards in its historical track record

Telecinco Cinema Films **THE IMPOSSIBLE**, **THE ADVENTURES OF TADEO JONES**, **TWICE BORN** and the short film **NEFERTITIS HAND** have received a total of **21 nominations for the 27th edition of the Goya Awards**, converting the cinematographic affiliate of Mediaset España into the **producer with the greatest presence** in the list of films that the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences has released this morning.

**THE IMPOSSIBLE**, directed by **Juan Antonio Bayona** and starring **Naomi Watts** and **Ewan McGregor**, won **14 nominations** and **THE ADVENTURES OF TADEO JONES**, **Jack Henry**, has been selected in **5 categories**.

Meanwhile, **Penelope Cruz**, star of the film by **Sergio Castellitto** **TWICE BORN**, has been nominated for a Goya for **Best Actress**, while from **NEFERTITIS HAND**, **Enrique Gato** was also selected for the award for **Best Animated Short Film**.

**THE IMPOSSIBLE** and **THE ADVENTURES OF TADEO JONES** have also been nominated for the **Gaudí Awards** given by The Catalan Film Academy every year, with **six nominations for the film by Bayona** (Best European Film, Best Direction, Best Editing, Best Sound, Best Cinematography and Best Makeup and Hair) and **4 nominations for the film by Enrique Gato** (Best Animated Film, Best Special Effects / Digital, Best Sound and Best Original Score).

### **THE IMPOSSIBLE, a favorite in The Goya Awards**

After becoming **the highest-grossing film in 2012** and the **second highest grossing in Spanish history with almost 42 million Euros in revenue**, **The Impossible** has been selected for the major prizes of the contest:

- **Best Picture**
- **Best Direction (JA Bayona)**
- **Best Actress (Naomi Watts)**
- **Best Supporting Actor (Ewan McGregor)**
- **Best Male Newcomer (Tom Holland)**
- **Best Original Screenplay (Sergio G. Sánchez)**

- **Best Special Effects**
- **Best Makeup and Hair**
- **Best Sound**
- **Best Editing**
- **Best Art Direction**
- **Best Original Music (Fernando Velázquez)**

**THE IMPOSSIBLE** is ranked as **one of the favorites** in the most important Spanish film awards with these nominations, after those already received by **Naomi Watts** in the **Golden Globes** and the **Screen Actors Guild Awards**, the **Desert Palms Achievement Award** collected by the actress on Saturday at the Palm Springs Film Festival, nominations for the film and its director at The **Detroit Critics Awards**, the **Hollywood Spotlight Award** received by **Tom Holland** and the **Emerging Visionary Award** which Bayona collected in the past at the Festival of Chicago

### **Five nominations for THE ADVENTURES OF TADEO JONES**

In turn, **the second most popular film of the year and the highest grossing Spanish animated film (more than 18 million Euros in revenue)** has been chosen to compete in these categories:

- **Best Animated Film**
- **Best New Director (Enrique Gato)**
- **Best Adapted Screenplay**
- **Best Original Score**
- **Best Original Song ("Te voy a esperar,(I'll wait for you) Juan Magan and Belinda)**

The winners of the most prestigious Spanish film festival will be announced during the awards ceremony which will take place **on February 17<sup>th</sup> at the Prince of Asturias Congress Centre** in Madrid.
